INSTRUCTIONS

- A Shareholder desirous of exercising her / his vote by Postal Ballot may complete this Postal Ballot Form and send it to the ScrA Shareholder desiro Ganpule, at Purva Sharegistry (India) Pvt. Ltd., 9, Shiv Shakti Industrial Estate, Ground Floor, Sitaram Mills Compound, J R Boricha Marg, Mumbai - 400 011.
- A tick mark should be placed in the relevant box signifying assent / dissent for the resolution, as the case may be, before mailing the Postal Ballot Form.
- Envelope containing Postal Ballot if sent by courier at the expense of the registered shareholder will also be accepted.
- The Postal Ballot Form should be completed and signed by the shareholder (as per the specimen signature registered with the Company) in case of joint holding, this from should be completed and signed by the first named shareholder and in his/her absence, by the next named shareholder. Unsigned Postal Ballot Forms will be rejected.
- Duly completed and signed Postal Ballot Forms should reach the Company on or before the close of working hours (5.00 P.M.) on December 27, 2017.
- Postal Ballot Forms received after the aforementioned date will be strictly treated as if the reply from the shareholder has not been received.
- Where the Postal Ballot Form has been signed by an authorized representative of a Body Corporate, Trust, Societies etc., a certified copy of the Board Resolution/ relevant authorization to vote on the Postal Ballot should accompany the Postal Ballot Form.

9. Voting rights shall be reckoned on the paid-up value of shares registered in the name of the Shareholder as on November 17, 2017 (cut-off date). The person who is not Shareholder as on the cut-off date should treat this notice for information purposes only.
10. Shareholders are requested not to send any other paper along with the Postal Ballot Forms in the enclosed addressed postage prepaid envelope as requested, as all such envelopes will be sent to the Scrutinizer and any extraneous paper found in such envelope would be destroyed by the Scrutinizer.
11. The Postal Ballot / remote e-voting shall not be exercised by a proxy.
12. There will be only one Postal Ballot Form for every folio / client ID irrespective of the number of Joint Shareholder(s).
13. Unsigned, incomplete or incorrectly ticked Postal Ballot Forms shall be rejected.
14. The Scrutinizer's decision on the validity of the Postal Ballot / remote e-voting will be final.
15. The result of the voting on the resolutions will be declared at the Registered Office of the Company at 1.00 P.M. on Thursday, December 28, 2017. The results will thereafter be also informed to the Stock Exchange on which the Equity Shares of the Company are listed and shall also be published on the Company's website www.shriramamc.com and published in newspapers.
16. The Shareholders can opt for any one mode of voting. In case, shareholder(s) cast vote by sending physical form as well as vote through remote e-voting, then voting done through physical form shall prevail and voting done by remote e-voting shall be treated as invalid.
17. **The Procedure / Instructions to members for voting electronically are as under:**
 - (i) The voting period begins on **Tuesday, November 28, 2017** at 9.00 A.M. and ends on **Wednesday, December 27, 2017** at 5.00 P.M. During this period shareholders of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date i.e. **Friday, November 17, 2017**, may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.
 - (ii) The Shareholders should log on to the e-voting website www.evotingindia.com.
 - (iii) Click on "Shareholders"/ "Members".
 - (iv) Now Enter your User ID
 - a. For CDSL: 16 digits beneficiary ID,
 - b. For NSDL: 8 Character DP ID followed by 8 Digits Client ID,
 - c. Members holding shares in Physical Form should enter Folio Number registered with the Company.
 - (v) Next enter the Image Verification as displayed and Click on Login.
 - (vi) If you are holding shares in demat form and had logged on to www.evotingindia.com and voted on an earlier voting of any company, then your existing password is to be used.
 - (vii) If you are a first time user follow the steps given below:

For Members holding shares in Demat Form and Physical Form	
PAN	Enter your 10 digit alpha-numeric PAN issued by Income Tax Department (Applicable for both demat shareholders as well as physical shareholders) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Members who have not updated their PAN with the Company/Depository Participant are requested to use the first two letters of their name and the 8 digits of the sequence number in the PAN field. • In case the sequence number is less than 8 digits enter the applicable number of 0's before the number after the first two characters of the name in CAPITAL letters. Eg. If your name is Ramesh Kumar with sequence number 1 then enter RA00000001 in the PAN field.
Dividend Bank Details OR Date of Birth (DOB)	Enter the Dividend Bank Details or Date of Birth (in dd/mm/yyyy format) as recorded in your demat account or in the company records in order to login. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If both the details are not recorded with the depository or company please enter the member id / folio number in the Dividend Bank details field as mentioned in instruction (iv).

- (viii) After entering these details appropriately, click on "SUBMIT" tab.
- (ix) Members holding shares in physical form will then directly reach the Company selection screen. However, members holding shares in demat form will now reach 'Password Creation' menu wherein they are required to mandatorily enter their login password in the new password field. ~~Kindly~~ note that this password is to be also used by the demat holders for voting for resolutions of any other company on which they are eligible that this password provided that company opts for e-voting through CDSL platform. It is strongly recommended not to share your password with any other person and take utmost care to keep your password confidential.
- (x) For Members holding shares in physical form, the details can be used only for e-voting on the resolutions contained in this Notice.
- (xi) Click on the EVSN for "**SHRIRAM ASSET MANAGEMENT COMPANY LIMITED**".
- (xii) On the voting page, you will see "RESOLUTION DESCRIPTION" and against the same the option "YES/NO" for voting. Select the option YES or NO as desired. The option YES implies that you assent to the Resolution and option NO implies that you dissent to the Resolution.
- (xiii) Click on the "RESOLUTIONS FILE LINK" if you wish to view the entire Resolution details.
- (xiv) After selecting the resolution you have decided to vote on, click on "SUBMIT". A confirmation box will be displayed. If you wish to cancel selecting the vote, click on "OK", else to change your vote, click on "CANCEL" and accordingly modify your vote.
- (xv) Once you "CONFIRM" your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.
- (xvi) You can also take a print of the votes cast by clicking on "Click here to print" option on the Voting page.
- (xvii) If a demat account holder has forgotten the changed login password then Enter the User ID and the image verification code and click on Forgot Password and enter the details as prompted by the system.
- (xviii) Shareholders can also cast their vote using CDSL's mobile app m-Voting available for android based mobiles. The m-Voting app can be downloaded from Google Play Store. iPhone and Windows phone users can download the app from the App Store and the Windows Phone Store respectively. Please follow the instructions as prompted by the mobile app while voting on your mobile.
- (xix) Note for Non - Individual Shareholders and Custodians:
 - Non Individual Shareholders (i.e. other than Individuals, HUF, NRI etc.) and Custodian are required to log on to www.evotingindia.com and register themselves as Corporates.
 - A scanned copy of the Registration Form bearing the stamp and sign of the entity should be emailed to helpdesk.evoting@cdslindia.com.
 - After receiving the login details a Compliance User should be created using the admin login and password. The Compliance user would be receiving link the account(s) for which they wish to vote on.
 - The list of accounts linked in the login should be mailed to helpdesk.evoting@cdslindia.com and on approval of the accounts they would be able to cast their vote.
 - A scanned copy of the Board Resolution and Power of Attorney (POA) which they have issued in favour of the Custodian, if any, should be uploaded in PDF format in the system for the scrutinizer to verify the same.
